Instructions for Authors

The script will be published in the conference proceedings. The DVG (Deutsche Veterinärmedizinische Gesellschaft – German Veterinary Medical Society, GVMS) has the non-exclusive right to store and to duplicate the script, to make it globally accessible, to produce printed and electronic copies. The author is entitled to make other use of his work. The conference proceedings with all the conference scripts will be sent to the Deutsche Nationalbibliothek (DNB). The DNB shall be granted the same rights to the scripts as the DVG.

In case the length of your abstract is limited you find the maximum number of characters in the corresponding “Call for Abstracts”.

Please write your text consecutively. You do not need to format the text. However, make sure that the abstract includes the following items which must be clearly recognizable:

- Affiliation
- Title of abstract
- Author(s)
- Subheadings (if necessary)
- Paragraphs (if necessary)
- References (if necessary)
- Complete details of corresponding author

Please note:

- Please send diagrams, charts, pictures and photos as separate files **and** include them in your abstract. Please indicate in your text where to place each diagram, chart, etc. (e.g., fig. 1, table 1). Please give each chart, picture, etc. a caption and name by whom rights are reserved (e.g., photo: John Doe or photo: Vet Clinic Anytown).
- We do **not accept** power point files, please submit your abstract as text file.
- Please send/upload the manuscript as word file – not as pdf file.
- The proceedings will be printed in **black and white**. Please use different patterns instead of colours for your graphs. Do not use a grey background for tables and figures.
